

**Guidelines for
Chisel Creek Ladies League
Thursdays at 4:30 PM 2009**

The league fee will be \$50.00 for Chisel Creek members and \$65.00 for non-members. This fee takes care of the weekly prizes, trophies, and banquet.

There has been a change in our weekly fees. Please note the options available.

Non-members:

Option 1: Pay \$30 each week (golf, cart, food)

Option 2: Pay \$25 each week (golf, cart) and \$125 by April 23 (food for the season)

CC Members:

Option 1: Pay \$7 each week (food)

Option 2: Pay \$125 by April 23 (food for the season) and have no weekly charge

Because you will be a member of Chisel Creek Ladies League you will be able to play at Chisel Creek for \$20 (9 hole w/cart) the rest of the week and weekends.

All Ladies League members will post their own scores after play.

Players will count all strokes until a handicap is earned. Once a handicap is established, players will use the "Equitable Stroke Control Table" to determine when to pick-up.

On **event** days all strokes are counted, adjustments will be made at clubhouse.

Through out the season there will be special formats run.

A Ringer Board will be posted every week. Players are to RING a score if they improve the score posted.

To qualify for the League Championship a player play at least 11 weeks of the schedule.

We will meet on the deck of the clubhouse after each round to award that round's prize and discuss rules, any problems or suggestions.

Something has been added this year, the #2 Club. We hope it will add a little more fun to our game.

Rules of the #2 Club

1. We have only two existing members of the "2 Club" with an official pin in our group, during the first 6 weeks of play anyone who scores a two on a hole becomes a member of the "2 Club" and can wear the "2 Club" pin! (The league will provide the pins)
2. Any other player who scores a two when playing with a "2 Club" member pays her \$1.00 and can join and wear the "2 Club" pin. All new "2 Club" members are then eligible to induct other players into the club.
3. Once a "2 Club" member, the player will also receive \$1.00 from the other "2 Club" members of the threesome or foursome whenever that player scores a two.
4. "2 Club" members must be wearing or displaying the official "2 Club" pin during the golf round to receive \$1.00 from the other members.
